



Hot Tub

Safety

WE TAKE OUR GUEST'S SAFETY AND WELL BEING VERY SERIOUSLY. RULES ARE IN PLACE TO ENSURE NO ONE GETS HURT WHILE ENJOYING YOUR STAY.

- Please shower before and after using the hot tub to remove all lotions, oils, etc...
- No soap or oils are allowed
- No more than 6 people at a time
- Use the stairs to enter and exit the hot tub
- Do not use the hot tub alone
- Do not use the hot tub if the water temperature is more than 104°F
- Absolutely NO glass of any kind allowed in or around the hot tub
- Anyone under 18 must be supervised by an adult. Children under 13 are not allowed
- Elderly or pregnant women should not use the hot tub
- People with heart disease, high or low blood pressure, diabetes or other illness should not use the hot tub
- People using alcohol or other drugs should not use the hot tub without consulting a physician
- No sex or nudity allowed in the hot tub
- Please do not pee in the hot tub
- Limit your time to 15 minutes and cool off before re-entry
- Do not use the hot tub cover as a table or a seat
- Please put the hot tub cover back on after use

Safety

SOME ADDITIONAL TIPS

- We check and treat the water after each guest has left.
- If the water is ever murky or discolored, do not enter the water and please call us right away so we can review and fix any issues
- Any glass or other safety hazards, please call us
- The hot tub has an automatic chlorine and mineral distribution system and does not require additional chlorine.
- A shock packet is available to guests to oxidize the water during there stay if needed. Normally shocking once a week is all that is needed unless longer stays or heavier hot tub usage occurs

WINTER

- There are disposable slippers available for when the weather is cold. Please wipe any dirt off the bottom of your feet before entering the hot tub
- There are robes available as well
- If there is snow on top of the hot tub, please use the soft scraper to remove it. The scraper is under the stair case in the basement by the hot tub towels

WINTER

- There are heated mats that lead to the hot tub. During snow storms, the mats will be on
- If you'd like to turn on the mats yourself, the switch to turn them on is located by the Keurig machine (see photo). Push the switch once to turn them on - they will turn off automatically in 2 hours

WATCH THE VIDEO

COVER CLIPS

Unclip all 4 clips on the hot tub cover.



LIFT THE FRONT

Lift up on the front of the hot tub cover. It will fold in half as you lift.

PULL ON THE COVER ASSIST BAR

Grab the cover assist bar and pull back. The covers halves will be pulled off together and stand up-right on the back of the hot tub.



ROTATE DISPLAY

In the upper right of the control panel is a button that will rotate the display 180 degrees so you can operate the hot tub in or out of the water.



TEMPERATURE

The temperature is locked to 100F. When using the control panel, a light touch is all that is needed.

LIGHT CONTROLS

Press the light bulb button to turn on the lights. Press multiple times for different colors and display modes.



JET CONTROLS

Press the jets button to see the jet controls screen.



JETS SCREEN

There are 3 jets to control. Touch each jet button to turn on that jet. The circulation pump runs all the time and cannot be turned off.

WATER AERATION

Flip the water aeration buttons on / off to control the air that is injected into the jets.



JET DIVERTERS

Rotate the diverters to send more or less water pressure to the jets in different seats.



WATERFALL

Turn the knob to control the waterfall.

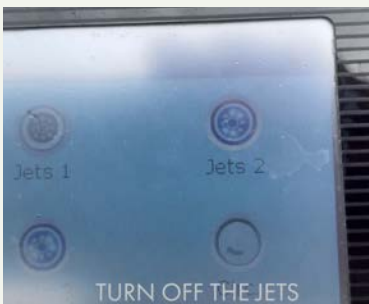

SCUMBUGS :)

These guys float around in the hot tub to help keep the water clean.



WHEN YOU'RE DONE: TURN OFF THE JETS

Make sure to turn off all three jets, the lights and stop the water fall



WHEN YOU'RE DONE: REPLACE THE COVER

Pull the cover assist bar to put the cover back and then pull the other half back. Clip back on all 4 clips.
